The Resilience Project delivers emotionally engaging programmes and provides evidence-based, practical strategies to build resilience.

Our Partnership Programme consists of online presentations and weekly lessons for students, professional development for staff, and Parent & Carer Hub (inc. digital presentations) for our parent and carer community.

The parent videos are 5-10 minutes long and will walk through the key pillars of resilience: **Gratitude**, **Empathy** & **Mindfulness**.

You'll hear stories and be introduced to activities to show how these strategies can support our kids' learning and development and support you as parents and carers.

This programme is an important part of our school's effort to look after the mental health of our school community.
